ANDALUSIAN BASIC EDUCATION DATA



- **Land: 20% of Spain. 8 provinces, 700 municipalities.**
- **Population: 8.500.000 (also around 20% of Spaniards)**
- **Regional decentralised educative system: Regional Ministry of Education, Culture and Sports.**
- **Competence: Non University System: +4.500 schools, around 100.000 teachers and 1.700.000 students. PUBLIC AND FREE OF CHARGE FOR USERS.**
- **Educacion General Secretary: 0-18 years old.**
- **VET and LLL General Secretary: Above 18(exceptionally 16)**
 - **DG of Initial VET and LLL**
 - **DG of VET for Employment.**



LIFELONG LEARNING SERVICE



- **Formal and non formal adult studies: face to face, blended and e-learning offer.**
- **Yearly tests for official Secondary and Post Second. certificates for adults: around 80.000 candidates a year.**
- **Second opportunities for adults: basic skills, drop outs, update and professional progress.**
- **± 900 schools, 5.000 certified primary and secondary teachers (civil servants) and 260.000 students:**
 - **E-learning: 10.000. Secondary, post secondary and languages, access to VC, University**
 - **Blended: 55.000. Secondary, post secondary and languages**
 - **Face to face: 195.000. The previous ones, formal and non formal + basic skills**

ANDALUSIAN LLL SCHOOL NETWORK



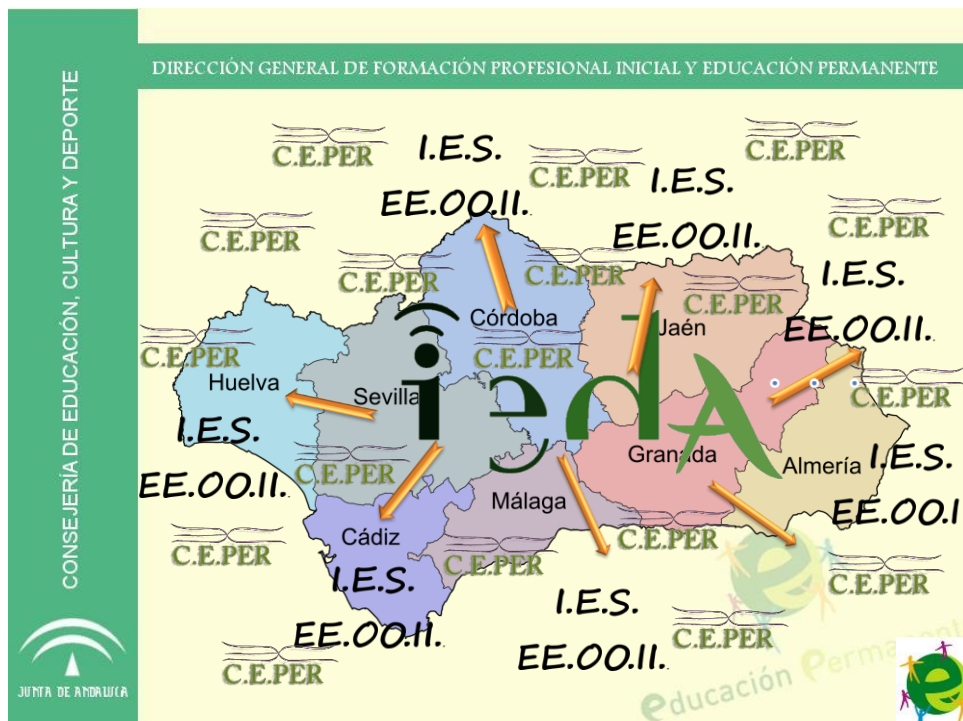
- **IEDA (Andalusian Regional E-learning Institute) 2010**
 - **E-learning, formal and non formal. 200 secondary teachers and 10.000 students**
 - **OER Materials revisión and updating + Innovation.**
- **51 EOI (Official Language Schools). 500 teachers. From 90's**
 - **Face to face: 44.000 / Blended: 18.000.**
- **175 IES (High Schools with evening lessons): 80's – 90's**
 - **Formal secondary and post secondary. 2.500 secondary teachers.**
 - **Face to face: 14.000 / Blended: 37.000 students**
- **670 CEPER (Adult schools) in nearly every municipality: 80's**
 - **Joint agreement with 670 Town Halls: building and energetic expenses**
 - **Face to face courses: 136.000 students and 2.000 primary teachers**
 - **Formal: Literacy, numeracy (primary for adults)**
 - **Non formal: key competences and connection with other studies and schools.**
 - **15 in prisons, 10 attending people under addictions, +100 in multicultural suburbs. Varied offer adapted to size of school, teachers and demand.**

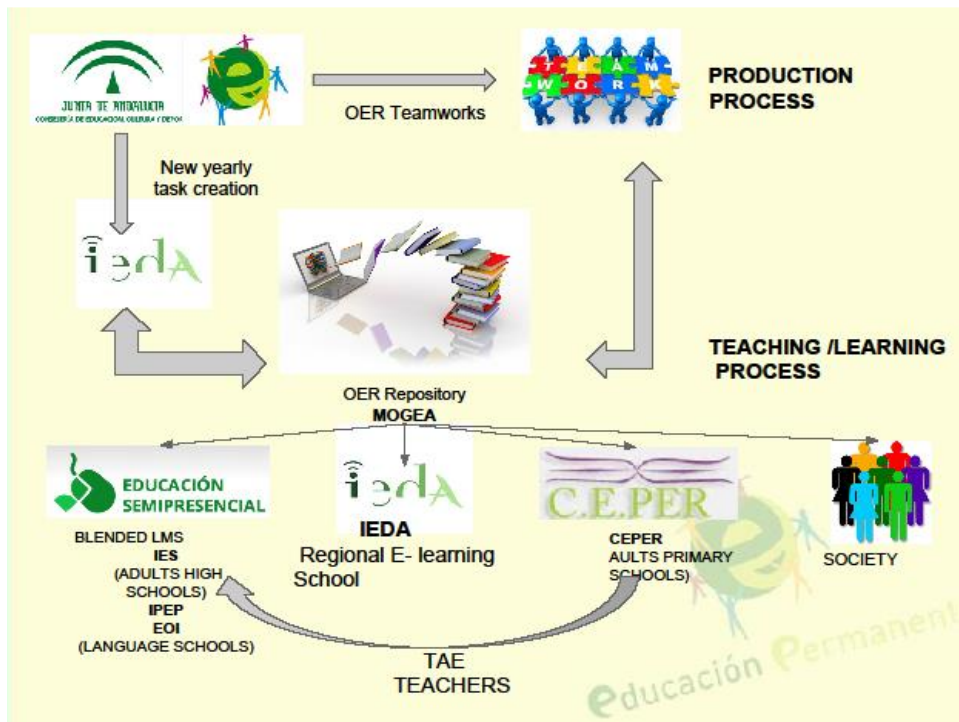




LLL NETWORKS

- **Geographical criteria: 3 - 5 nets for province.**
- **Coordinated adult needs detection and offer of LLL Schools.**
- **Learning opportunities and assessment: what to do, where, how..**
- **Priorities:**
 - **Catch up of low skilled: samples.**
 - **Educative system official certificates: Secondary and post sec.**
 - **Access to other levels: VET, University+25**
 - **Learning for social inclusion.**
 - **Learning for active citizenship.**





LLL PRINCIPLES

- **Promotion of Andalusian LLL School Networks: 30 nets**
 - 3 in Almería, Córdoba, Jaén, Huelva.
 - 4 in Granada and Cádiz.
 - 5 in Málaga and Sevilla.
- **European framework 2020 > Far away from Andalusian reality, especially in compulsory education > challenge**
- **National and regional framework: Education laws**
- **Main objectives. provide basic skills, 2nd opportunities, connection with other formal studies.....**
- **Strong bet for methodological and technical innovation.**
- **Didactic resources and tools for education community.**



EU FRAMEWORK



- **2020 Objectives after some of 2012 Lisbon's not fulfilled.**
- **Recovery of early drop outs and flexible pathways.**
- **Recognition:**
 - Professional competence and skills.
 - Formal and non-formal learning.
- **Key competencies, second opportunities, social cohesion...**
- **Lifelong learning policies supported in:**
 - ICT and task based learning + OER resources.
 - Web info and assessment about learning opportunities.
- **Teachers updating and training programs > strategic plan based on established priorities depending on the type of school teachers work.**

NATIONAL AND REGIONAL FRAMEWORK

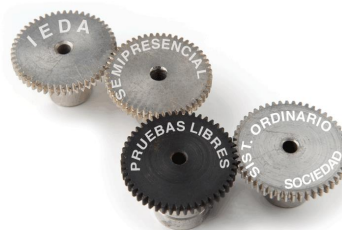


- **From 2007 onwards: wide and flexible offer to match personal, familiar and professional duties and interests with learning / training**
- **Personalised learning pathways + Prior learning recognition.**
- **Adapting to different profiles and needs: face to face, blended and E learning.**
- **Set of support media: website, OER repository, LMS, users call service.**
- **OER (EU 2030 strategy): open digital interactive, multimedia objects .**
- **Innovative software tools "Moodle", Exe-learning, CC licenses.....**
- **Automatic procedures: SÉNECA, VIRTUAL SECRETARY.....**

KEY FACTOR I: FLEXIBILITY IS BASIC / MANY WAYS TO REACH GOALS

- Website (soon in English, hopefully)
- Digital and multimedia didactic materials and resources
- Tests samples.
- Manuals and documents (CREA/MOGEA)

New Teachers and students welcome plan
Schools. Nets, Province Services, Central Services



OER AND LESSONS PROPOSED METHODOLOGICAL APPROACH

- **Integrated, contextualised and practical approach, adapted to adult learner.**
- **Practical, students centred based learning.**
- **Change in teachers and students role in learning process: active, participative... horizontal learning.**
- **Graded assesment, taking into account all processess happening in learning and consequent with the learning model proposed: assistance, interest, homework, LMS, work, term tests.....**



OUTCOMES AND MIRACLES

- **Inclusion and equality for disadvantaged groups (samples)**
- **Generations of post civil war men, especially in 80's and 90's**
- **Migrants coming to Andalusia for farming and bilding. 2000**
- **Second opportunities for young adults who failed at compulsory school.**
- **Summing up: giving an answer for learning/ training lacks or needs.**
